The session also highlights key benefits such as early retirement, lifetime income, and secure online access through Your Pension Profile (YPP).

Members can receive 1.50 hour paid time off for the duration of the webinars and up to 4 hours for the in-person sessions. No other expenses will be covered for the registered session.
